Federal and International Hunting Horn Festival 2026

Dear hunting horn players, esteemed hunting horn groups

It's that time again! On May 30th 2026, the 32nd Federal and International Hunting Horn Festival (EIJBF26) will take place in Liestal, BL.

Conditions of participation:

Hunting horn groups are admitted if at least two thirds of the wind players are entitled to hunt (the musical director is excluded from the count), exceptions are possible, see regulations.

The different categories are listed in the regulations. The groups can decide for themselves in which group they compete.

The registration fees have been reduced. Groups that are members of JHBCH pay CHF 25 per person, non-members CHF 35.

Catering:

Lunch costs CHF 30. This includes coffee and croissants in the morning, lunch with salad, main course and dessert as well as mineral water and coffee at noon. Catering facilities are available for visitors at the game stands.





Signal groups and schedule:

After receipt of all registrations (registration deadline is 15 February, late registrations are possible until 15 March), the match times will be drawn. These will be sent by e-mail together with the drawn signal groups on 4 April.

To the general festival schedule:

On Friday evening, 29.05.26, a concert of the Académie Trompe et Cors will take place in the town church of Liestal with various hunting horn groups from Europe as well as a young horn quartet from the Liestal Music School. So it is worth arriving a day earlier.
